

CAG Meeting #4 Review

- All 27 Alternatives were Reviewed
- Outlined the Evaluation Process/Introduced the Fatal Flaw Analysis
- Applied the Fatal Flaw Analysis
- 13 Alternatives Remained for Evaluation









Progress Following CAG #4

- Purpose and Need received concurrence from NEPA – July 2013
- Performed further screening evaluation
- 13 alternatives were evaluated 3 remained for further evaluation
- Environmental Field Review Scheduled October 2013
- Environmental Field Review postponed due to government shutdown







Progress Continued

- Environmental Field Review rescheduled/conducted in May 2014
- Impacts to environmental resources are cited by the USACE and USFWS
- Led to a reconsideration of all 27 original alternatives








Revised Screening Process

Round 1 Screening: Environmental and/or Engineering Obstacles

- 27 Alternatives were evaluated
- 14 Alternatives and the no-build remained









Environmental and Engineering Obstacles

Round 1 Screening: Environmental and/or Engineering Obstacles

- Lake Renwick East Land and Water Reserve property (LWR)
- No paving, grading or altering natural water flow allowed on LWR unless imperative and unavoidable public necessity for public use



Lake Renwick East Land and Water Reserve






Revised Screening Process

Round 2 Screening: Environmental Screening

- 3 additional alternatives were developed
- 17 alternatives plus the no-build were evaluated
- 5 alternatives remain









Environmental Screening Factors

Environmental Screening

- Avoid or minimize impacts to wetlands or Waters of the US (Lily Cache Creek & Slough)
- Avoid bisecting wetland areas
- Minimize impacts to Section 4(f) properties
- Minimize residential and business displacements

Environmental resource agencies concurred







Progress Continued

- Alternatives to be Carried Forward received concurrence from NEPA – July 2015
- Received updated CMAP 2040 traffic projections
- Round 3 Screening evaluation factors developed
- Refined design of 5 remaining alternatives
- Coordination with IDOT, the FHWA, Plainfield Park District & three villages









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

























Natural Environment Evaluation Factors

- Water Resources: Impacts to watershed area for Lily Cache Creek and Lily Cache Slough
- Wetlands: Impacts to wetland areas and Waters of the US
- Special Waste: Recognized Environmental Conditions sites impacted
- Threatened and Endangered Species: Species
 Impacted
- Parklands (4f): Park Area Impacted







Human Environment Evaluation Factors

- Cultural Resources: Historic & archaeologic sites impacted
- Residences: Homes displaced or impacted
- Businesses: Businesses displaced or impacted
- Recreational Clubs: Recreational/sportsman clubs areas impacted

- ROW from Businesses, Residences or other uses
- Total Right of Way Required
- Estimated Project Cost







Traffic Operations Evaluation Factors
